





<p>Grand Canyon Lone Rock Beach</p>	<p>Drive to Grand Canyon (buy America the Beautiful National Park Pass) Grand Canyon Skywalk</p> <p>Hike Bright Angel Trail While most steep, undeveloped trails descending below the South Rim are not suitable for young children, the Bright Angel Trail is wide and fairly graded with rest houses located a mile-and-a half and three miles below the rim (a good place to turn around). Keep in mind that while children may eagerly hike down the trail, hiking back up can be grueling for children (and parents) and should be avoided during mid-day heat.</p> <p>Walk to Shoshone Point Even young children can hike to this quiet South Rim overlook, which is accessible via a level, gated one-mile dirt road. The path meanders through the ponderosa pine forest and ends at Shoshone Point, where there are picnic tables next to the rim. There are restrooms but no water available.</p> <p>Hopi Point - uphill climb</p> <p>Drive to Lone Rock Beach Campground Lone Rock Rd, Page, UT 86040, United States No reservations. \$14 per vehicle/per night in addition to entry fees. Primitive camping is on a sandy beach or in dunes. No designated campsites. Open fires permitted, must be within four foot squared area. Quiet time 10pm-6am. 4 micro flush toilets, 6 vault toilets, 1 comfort station/wheelchair accessible, outdoor cold shower, Off Road Vehicle area, dump station, potable water (seasonal), and day use area.
